### 2017 Lower-IncomePet Cat Spay/Neuter and Veterinary Care Assistance Vouchers **Veterinary Clinic Registration**

If you'd like to become a participating veterinary clinic in our [Lower-Income Cat Spay/Neuter Program](#) and our [Veterinary Care Assistance Program](#), simply complete the enclosed registration application and e-mail it back to us. We'll add you to the list of [Participating Veterinary Clinics](#) that's mailed out with our vouchers so recipients can contact you for appointments.

Our service area presently includes the New Mexico counties of Bernalillo, Catron, Colfax, McKinley, Rio Arriba, San Juan, San Miguel, Sandoval, Santa Fe, Socorro, Taos, Torrance and Valencia. Other counties that we are currently not represented in but would like to include are Cibola, Los Alamos, Guadalupe, Harding, and Union.

Although we do no formal advertising of these programs, we are a standard referral from many vet clinics, animal welfare and control agencies throughout our service area. We include a poster with all vouchers we mail asking the recipients to post on a public bulletin board in their community to let their friends and neighbors know about our service.

If you receive calls from caregivers in our service area who wish to get their pet cats fixed -- or have a sick cat without the money to seek treatment -- ask them to call us. We'll take a brief telephone application and if we can approve it, will provide them with vouchers.

The voucher-recipients are asked to call a participating clinic to set up their appointments and give the clinic our voucher when the cat goes in for treatment. When the work is completed the clinic provides us with their invoice (billed at the pricing on their registration) and a copy of our voucher. Vouchers can also be billed monthly. We'll mail payment normally within 1-3 business days of the submission. If payment isn't received within a week the clinic should follow up with us.

Providing the community with free and local spay/neuter through area vet clinics is the best way to ensure that all cats get fixed increasing long-term pet retention rates while lowering both shelter euthanasia rates and feral colony populations. What a great way to do community service!

<b>Cat Spay Package.</b> Includes brief day-of surgery exam, spay surgery, rabies vaccination, take-home pain medication and taxes. <i>(Acceptable price range per package is \$64-\$100.)</i>	
<b>Cat Pregnant Spay Package.</b> Includes brief day-of surgery exam, pregnant spay surgery, rabies vaccination, take-home pain medication and taxes. <i>(Acceptable price range per package is \$84-\$120.)</i>	
<b>Cat Neuter Package.</b> Includes brief day-of-surgery exam, neuter surgery, rabies vaccination, take-home pain medication and taxes. <i>(Acceptable price range per surgery is \$50-\$75).</i>	
<b>Cat Cryptorchid Neuter Package.</b> Includes brief day-of-surgery exam, cryptorchid neuter surgery, rabies vaccination, take-home pain medication and taxes. (For more-complex abdominal cryptorchid, call for Veterinary Care Voucher (below). <i>(Acceptable price range per simple cryptorchid surgery is \$70-\$95).</i>	
<b>Optional Parasite Treatment.</b> Add-on (including taxes) for cats with visible mites, worms or fleas on day of surgery. <i>(Acceptable price range is \$5-\$15.)</i>	
<b>Optional FVRCP Vaccination.</b> Add-on (including taxes) for an FVRCP shot given on the day of surgery. <i>(Acceptable price range is \$5-\$15.)</i>	
<b>Optional microchip.</b> Add-on for implanting and registering microchip on day of surgery. (Acceptable price range \$5-\$30).	
<b>Veterinary Care Assistance Vouchers.</b> Covers up to \$300 to treat a minor non-emergency health issue costing less than \$600 overall -- such as a bite wound, injury or infection. For more-complicated procedures such as those involving x-rays, lab work or anesthesia we may require a written estimate for approval. Caregiver eligibility is limited to food stamp recipients or equivalent verification.	Reasonable and customary fees NTE voucher maximum of \$300.
